3 Q. Now, did you examine Officer Gonzalez's vest for any
4 marks consistent with the vest stopping a projectile?

5 A. Yes.

6 Q. All right. And tell us about your examination.

7 A. I looked this vest over very carefully, and it's my
8 opinion that there are no obvious bullet strikes on this
9 vest.

10 Q. All right. And did you also examine a shirt of Officer
11 Gonzalez, Exhibit 56?

12 A. Yes.

13 Q. All right. And did you also do an examination to see
14 if there were any tears or punctures consistent with a
15 bullet or projectile going into it?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. All right. And did you find any?

18 A. I did not find any.

19 Q. All right. Now, can you describe what happens to
20 pieces of metal that you talked about as fragments in your
21 testimony at a scene where there are multiple guns being
22 shot and hitting multiple items?

23 A. Very often at shooting scenes where there are more than
24 one -- more than one firearm is being fired, there's often
25 quite a few fragments flying in the air from the bullet
