

1 of the shooting. You've changed out of a black hoodie and
2 the black gloves.

3 You can change your hair. Your hair can be styled.
4 You can have cornrows. Your hair can be cut. Your hair can
5 be washed. And a lot has been said about this.

6 Mr. Klyman showed you a photograph of his client,
7 Mr. Kirkland, in the hospital. And the photograph of
8 Mr. Kirkland in the hospital, when you go to the jury room
9 and look at, shows hair extremely tight to his head. Just
10 so very tight to his head that you can see the outline of
11 where the hair goes and it's just pulled back very tight as
12 he lay in the hospital bed. The photograph is of horrible
13 quality. You really can't see much.

14 But when you look at Mr. Kirkland's booking photos even
15 from two years before when he had the cornrows in his hair,
16 you see how tight his hair is when it's pulled back with
17 cornrows. And you look at the booking photo. There's a
18 booking photo that Officer Estrada took six days later, six
19 days later, and that will show you hair that's certainly not
20 pulled back and very tight, and actually has some height or
21 some puff to it so it's not pulled back right on the head.
22 It's over the head. It has some height to it in the
23 hospital, but that's six days later. And Officer Estrada
24 doesn't know what happened during those six days.

25 Certainly Mr. Kirkland was cleaned up because you know

1 he was absolutely covered with blood and went through
2 medical procedures and had his clothes cut off of him and
3 then clean clothes put on him and had his needs attended to,
4 and he wasn't left there filthy and dirty and bloody. So
5 the point is, hairstyles change and can change.

6 The people who describe the different hair is, number
7 one, Darryl King who saw this individual while he had a hood
8 on. Saw him with a hood on and said braids when he had a
9 hood on. The people who saw him without a hood on include
10 Carolyn Wright who said cornrows, Officer Gregorczyk who
11 said cornrows, Officer Capozza who said cornrows.

12 And you know from his 2009 booking photo when he wears
13 cornrows, his hair is just pulled back very tight, very low
14 to his forehead. So you can look at the hospital
15 photograph, as grainy as it is, and see how low it is to the
16 forehead and how different that is from his booking photo
17 six days later. Hairstyles can change.

18 He didn't still have the bloody clothes on at the
19 hospital. Those were all cut off of him and he was clean.

20 Distinguishing characteristics, distinguishing
21 characteristic.

22 You can take that down.

23 Distinguishing characteristics which cannot be changed,
24 those would include height. Those would include height.
