5 Now, there's a second part to this case. That second
6 part occurred at 46 Burr Street. And 46 Burr Street, you
7 will hear, was not a typical house. It wasn't your normal
8 neighborhood house. It was a house that was known to the
9 police as a beehive of activity. A lot of people coming in
10 and out of that house.

11 And what you are going to find is Tamik Kirkland was at
12 that house. He was a guest of that house and he was in the
13 area staying at that house. He was laying low from the
14 police.

15 The police descended upon this area after the shooting
16 and they posted up or they sat down the street by 46 Burr
17 Street, and about 20 minutes after the shooting at the
18 barbershop, the police notice something. They notice
19 something that made them suspicious. They saw a car and
20 this car was driven by a woman named Karen Fuller.

21 Ms. Fuller had two children in that car, a six-month-old
22 child named Maurice and a twelve-year-old named Montiarara.

23 And Ms. Fuller did something that made them suspicious,
24 that made the police suspicious. She backed her car into
25 this driveway at Burr Street, a house that police knew to
